IMPORTANT MESSAGE from the SBCDS Board

You've probably noticed that there aren't as many people sharing in the joy of contra dancing as there used to be. We're sad that they're missing out on the fun, but it's becoming a financial problem too.

It may surprise you to learn that after paying the band, the caller, the sound guy, the rent on the hall, and various smaller expenses, we lose \$400 most Sundays, sometimes more. In July alone we lost nearly \$2,000! This is not sustainable. Most of the expenses for each dance are fixed; they are the same whether we have 2 or 200 dancers. What we need are more dancers!

This is where you come in. Spread the word! Bring your friends! Invite your co-workers, your neighbors, your mailman... And then let's work together to make sure that new dancers feel welcome and have a good time so they'll become regular dancers too.

Suggestions and (especially) volunteer contributions are also always welcome. Feel free to attend the Board meetings or share your ideas with a Board Member at a dance.
